

PUGIN WEEK 7th-14th September

A WEEK CELEBRATING THE LIFE AND WORK OF AWN PUGIN, CREATOR OF ST AUGUSTINE'S, RAMSGATE.

SATURDAY 7TH SEPTEMBER -

Ride and Stride for Churches. St Augustine's will be open 10am to 4pm to welcome participants.

SUNDAY 8TH SEPTEMBER -

12 noon – Missa Cantata for the 13th Sunday after Pentecost (EF). Beautiful liturgy, Gregorian chant from St Augustine's choir and a chance for all to experience the Traditional Latin Mass.

16.30 – Vespers & Benediction sung by St Augustine's choir. Part of the monastic daily office, sung to Gregorian chant and a chance to experience a timeless liturgy.

17.30 – Unveiling of replica Pugin altar frontal from the Church of the Immaculate Conception, Farm Street. Fr Dominic Robinson SJ will speak about this unique item gifted to us by the London Jesuit church. Refreshments provided.

MONDAY 9TH SEPTEMBER -

19.30 – Mr Jeremy Tomlinson MA, Secretary of the Friends of Lancing Chapel, will give an illustrated lecture about the chapel at Lancing College designed by RH Carpenter, sometimes called the 'Anglican Pugin'.

TUESDAY 10TH SEPTEMBER -

19.30 – The Administrator of the Shrine, Fr Simon Heans, who taught Victorian history for many years, will share the fruits of his reading about the Catholic Church before and after Emancipation. He will also discuss why Pugin became a Catholic and his understanding of Catholicism.

Wednesday 11th September -

19.30 – Catriona Blaker MA, founder member of the Pugin Society, will give a talk entitled Marvellous Minton: a look at the life and achievements of the Victorian potter par excellence, Herbert Minton (1793-1858), his connection with Pugin, and much more.
